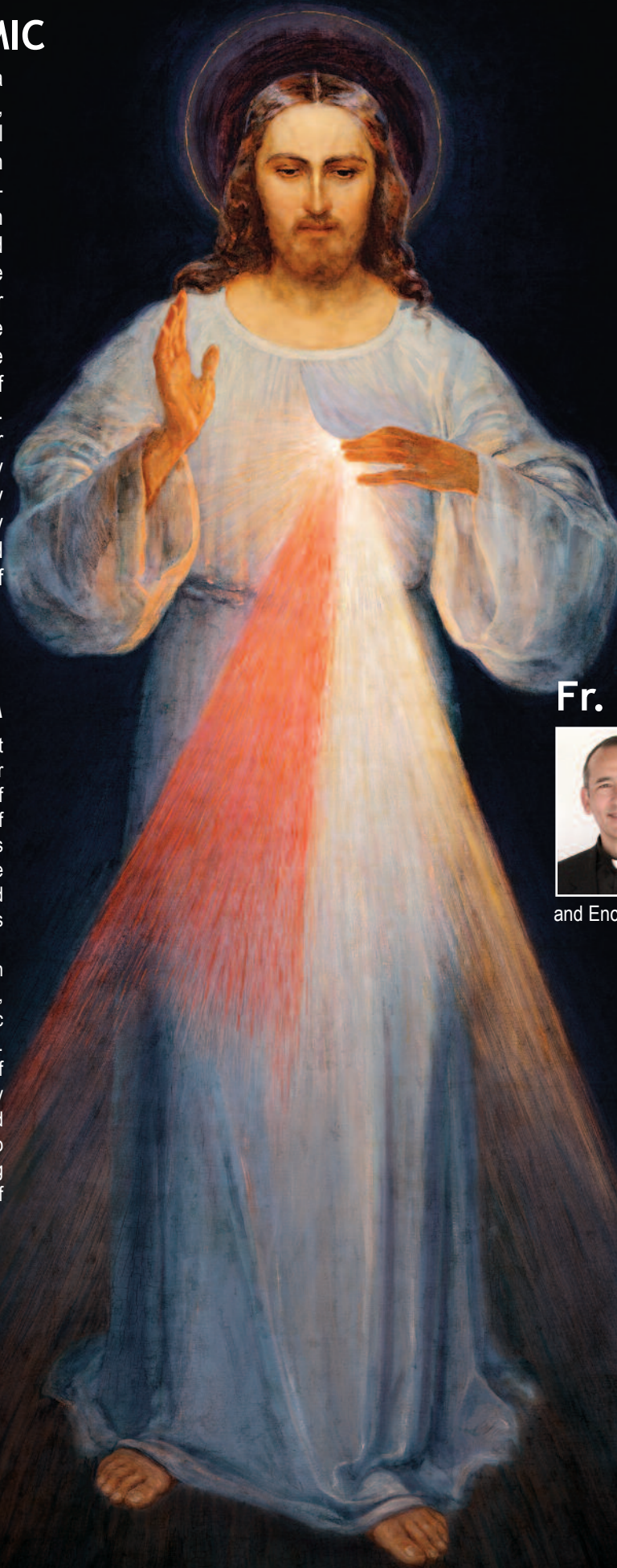
Jesse Romero

and Encourage.

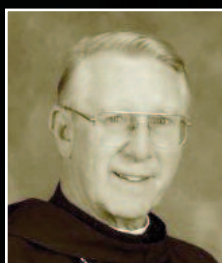
Music Ministry Donna Lee
